



# CHBC

## Questionnaire summary

There were 43 respondents of which the vast majority have been at CHBC for over 3 years & usually attend each week. 29 are members and 29 belong to a small group. The following stats were calculated from responses to each question. As not all questions were answered, 100% does not always mean 43 responses.

### Worship & teaching:-

- 70% felt the style of music/worship met their need
- Over 70% felt both adult & youth teaching on Sundays met their needs
- Over 70% felt family service content & frequency met their needs

### Care & fellowship:-

- 84% felt small groups were accessible & their activities met their need
- A number of individuals stated that they might be interested in joining a small group
- 74% felt the care provided at CHBC met their need
- 42% felt social activities should be more frequent

### Serving & local community:-

- There was an overwhelming majority who felt children's activities (93%) and youth work (85%) met their needs
- 67% felt service to the elderly met their needs (this dropped to 57% for those respondents over 70 years of age)
- 45% felt there needed to be some

### Mission & outreach:-

- 37% felt there could be more information available from charities & missionaries CHBC supports
- 37% felt there needed to be some change with the frequency of guest speakers
- 55% felt they would like more opportunity to get involved with Mission & Outreach

### Resources:-

- Around 80% felt the weekly news sheet & website was informative
- 29% felt there could be better information available on CHBC activities
- 64% felt the church premises needed some/lots of improvement

### There were lots of comments made & below is a summary.

- Worship is often exuberant, meditative & connected to the word
- Requests for both livelier & new songs also more traditional ones
- Different styles/approach to prayer (prayer board is as a result)
- More people to be involved with services to give variation
- Caring fellowship - people are cared for in many ways
- Provide welcome packs for new worshipers
- Other socials incl bowling, cultural evenings, cinema, theatre, games night, care home/hospice visit, outdoor activities
- Need to think about how activities can be more representative of church demographics
- Small groups could benefit from occasionally using the same material. Consider mixing groups up also
- We are serving the community within CHBC but not outside
- Alpha is good but perhaps we could try something else as well
- Consider starting/joining in with community projects like removing graffiti, gardening etc
- Need to encourage more people to visit our elderly family
- Perhaps we should consider/vary how we do communion
- Consider opportunities for next door & develop closer relations
