We heard the sad news during the week that Henry Webb passed away peacefully in his sleep on April 20th at 4.30 p.m. He formed the Falconer Trust in 1980 to provide support for the Falconer Children's Home and Orphanage in Zambia run by Liliias Falconer although he had been actively supporting her work since the early 1950's. A service of celebration of the life of Henry will be held at South Park Chapel, Ripley Road, Seven Kings will take place on Tuesday, 4th May at 2.30 p.m. It was his wish that all tributes should go to the Falconer Trust to support the ongoing work of the children's Home in Kabulamena.
